## HIGH FIRE DANGER

### **DUE TO LOW MOISTURE AND HIGH TEMPERATURES, THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS ARE IN EFFECT WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE PUEBLO OF LAGUNA**

1. Building, maintaining, attending or using fire, or charcoal-burning device is prohibited.
2. Burning of trash and yard debris.
3. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle, building and designated areas.
4. All Fireworks, except for the Pueblo sponsored July 3<sup>rd</sup> Celebration held at the K'AWAIKA Center.
5. Operating an internal combustion engine without a spark arrestor other than a motor vehicle in wildland areas.
6. Welding or operating an acetylene or other torch with open flame in wildland areas.

#### *Exceptions:*

Fires that are related to traditional ceremonies, religious events and wakes. (Please Consult with the Laguna Fire Protection Program)

#### *Penalties for violations:*

Section 15-11-2. - Reckless burning.

*Sentence.* Any person found guilty of reckless burning shall be sentenced to a jail term not to exceed one hundred eighty (180) days, or be ordered to pay a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or both.

Section 15-14-4. - Maintaining or creating a public nuisance.

*Sentence.* Any person found guilty of maintaining a public nuisance shall be sentenced to a jail term not to exceed thirty (30) days, or be ordered to pay a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00), or both.

**THESE RESTRICTIONS SHALL BE IN EFFECT STARTING JUNE 24, 2016, AND WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL MORE FAVORABLE CONDITIONS EXIST AND UNTIL RESCINDED BY THE PUEBLO OF LAGUNA**
