

Section 7-2-281. Status Offenses.

H. *Use, procurement or possession of an e-cigarette or nicotine liquid container.* No child, or person under this Code, shall use, procure or attempt to procure or be in possession of an e-cigarette or nicotine liquid container for the child's own use or for use by another child.

1. An "e-cigarette" means any electronic oral device, that provides a vapor of nicotine or any other substance, including any such device, or any part thereof, whether manufactured, distributed, marketed or sold as an e-cigarette, e-cigar, e-pipe or any other product, name or descriptor.

2. A "nicotine liquid container" means a bottle or other container of any substance containing nicotine where the substance is sold, marketed or intended for use in an e-cigarette.

Sentence: Any child, or person subject to the Code, shall be subject to community service not to exceed 20 hours, and juvenile probation not to exceed four (4) months. In addition, the court may require completion of a Nicotine Awareness program as a condition of community service and/or juvenile probation.

I. *Use, procurement or possession of a tobacco product.* No child, or person under this Code, shall use, procure or attempt to procure or be in possession of a tobacco product for the child's own use or for use by another child, except possession and usage in accordance with the religious and traditional purposes of the Pueblo.

A "tobacco product" means any product made from the tobacco plant for the purpose of smoking, chewing, inhaling or any other use, including cigars, chewing tobacco, pipe tobacco, snuff, and cigarettes in any form.

Sentence: Any child, or person subject to the Code, shall be subject to community service not to exceed 20 hours, and juvenile probation not to exceed four (4) months. In addition, the court may require completion of a Nicotine Awareness program as a condition of community service and/or juvenile probation.
